

OpenWith Enhanced

A better way to open files

Windows generally makes opening files easy. You double-click on a file and it opens in the correct program. What could be easier?

Except when it doesn't work as expected. The file might be associated with the wrong program. At times, Windows can't determine which program to use.

The most basic solution is to right-click on the file and select Open With. That allows you to select which program to use with the file.

However, Open With is basic, with many limitations.

That's why you need OpenWith Enhanced. It adds cool new features to the Open With command. For example, it shows you all the programs that are capable of opening the type of file you indicate. From that list, you can either select a program that's already installed on your computer, or choose a new one. In that case, this program will transport you directly to the download page for your selection.

It's very helpful if you aren't sure what programs will open the file you have chosen. OpenWith Enhanced gets program suggestions from other users. It will display the best options for you, so you don't have to waste time guessing.

OpenWith Enhanced offers other benefits. For instance, you can set file associations for specific users on a shared computer.

When two people share a computer but prefer different programs, this is a killer feature.
