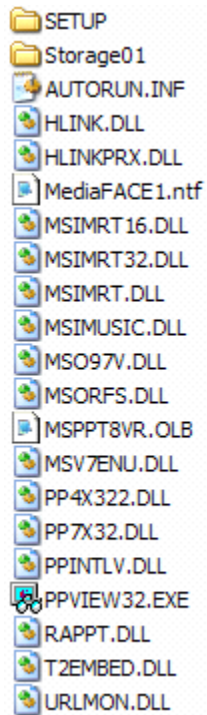


Following is a set of instructions to create a self booting Power Point Presentation. You may want to print this page for reference.



First, be sure the Power Point Presentation is saved as a ".pps" file.

Instructions:

- 1) Create a new folder on hard drive "C" to store the required files and folders above.
- 2) Name the new folder "Create a Bootable Power Point".
- 3) Copy the above list of files to the assigned folder.
- 4) Copy the Power Point Presentation, ".pps" file to the "Storage01" folder.
- 5) Rename the Power Point file to "001.pps".
- 6) Burn all of the files and folders to a CD-R.
- 7) Note: Once the CD has been created be sure to delete the "pps" file in the "Storage01" folder.

You have now created a bootable CD you can use to auto-boot a Power Point Presentation. Note: This program will allow you to view a P.P Slide Show even if the PC you are using does not have the Power Point program installed on the hard drive.
