

# DriverGuide Driver Scan

DriverGuide Driver Scan is a versatile program that will find and display all the device drivers installed on your computer. When you run Driver Scan, the software immediately begins to list the devices on your computer, and you will be able to see all your drivers perfectly categorized.

It may take a few minutes to search the DriverGuide.com on line database, but when the search is finished you will be advised if you have an up to date driver for a specific device and be given a download link for those that are out of date. Many of the download links are for drivers that have been added by users of the DriverGuide web site and not from the manufacturer's web site. This is a great place to find legacy drivers, but be careful about accepting the recommendations for drivers for recent devices.

To insure that the proper drivers are being downloaded and eventually installed, you need to note the version number and check with the manufacturer's web site. Many manufacturer web sites tell you what is available but don't indicate which versions are to be used with your computer. You may then compare the version that is listed against the manufacturer's web site to determine if you have the correct most recent drivers.

A good rule of thumb for drivers is "if it works, don't fix it". If you are having trouble with some device then looking for a driver is appropriate. If things are working right but you just want to "tweak it", and are willing to take a chance – go ahead.
