

NetMeter

NetMeter can be considered a small, yet comprehensive and customizable network bandwidth monitoring application. Realtime bandwidth monitoring was never easier.

Note: Some antivirus and antispymware programs flag NetMeter as being infected/malware, although the application is perfectly safe and does not pose a threat to your system. This is called a 'false positive'. The term false positive is used when antivirus software wrongly classifies an innocuous (inoffensive) file as a virus. The incorrect detection may be due to heuristics or to an incorrect virus signature in a database. [Similar problems can occur with antitrojan or antispymware software]

Requirements:

- Windows 2000 or newer is required for "transparency" and "balloon hint" features
- If you are using Windows 95 you will have to install an update from Microsoft that contains the IP-Helper API (IPHLPAPI.DLL).
